Owen Roberts International Airport

Owen Roberts International Airport (code GCM) is government-owned and services over a dozen airlines. The airport is named after Owen Roberts, a pioneer of commercial aviation in the country.

It is the airport for the Cayman Islands as well as the main base for Cayman Airways. Cayman Airways manages all counters as well as handles all baggage concerns. Owen Roberts is also the last international airport in the Caribbean with an “open-air” passenger waving gallery.

Expansion is underway to double the size of the terminal to handle more than 2 million passengers and offer more food and retail vendors to the public. Completion is estimated to be reached the first half of 2018.
